

POCKET TEDDY PATTERNS

Pocket teddy from a square



Cast on 24 stitches
2 rows for feet
10 rows for trousers
10 rows for jumper
12 rows for head

Cast off & make up as follows

Iron edges flat. Turn square to wrong side and tie off colour joins to secure. Pin long sides together matching colours. Starting at the bottom, sew backstitch seam 2 stitches from edge. Pin top edges and sew with backstitch seam.

Turn to right side and lift out top corners if necessary with wool needle for ear point.

Sew running stitch from front and back on diagonal for each ear and gather slightly to shape to the front.

Fill tube with stuffing, firming head shape until well filled.

Sew across base of tube adding extra fibre if necessary.

Legs - Stitch from centre front through to centre back to divide body in half, starting about 4 rows below waist.

Arms - Stitch arms starting at waist and sew up to about 3 rows below neck.

Neck - With head colour and starting at side seam, sew running stitch around bottom row of head shape and pull two ends together tightly to shape neck. Tie off and secure.

Features - Mark position of eyes with pins. Embroider eyes, nose and mouth with darker wool.

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Pocket Teddy 2



DK 3mm

1st leg

Cast on 4 stitches

Knit 8 rows

Leave on needle

2nd leg

Cast on 4 stitches

Knit 8 rows

Knit across all stitches (8 stitches)

Knit 3 rows

Cast on 4 stitches at beginning next 2 rows

Knit 4 rows

Cast off 4 stitches beginning of next 2 rows

Knit 22 rows (body & head)

Cast on 4 stitches at beginning next 2 rows

Knit 4 rows

Cast off 4 stitches beginning of next 2 rows

Knit across all stitches

Knit 3 rows

Work on first 4 stitches only

Knit 8 rows

Cast off

Rejoin to remaining 4 stitches

Knit 8 rows

Cast off

Sew up sides & legs & stuff

Add facial features

Weave yarn through to make ears

Weave yarn to form the head above the arms. Pull tight & fasten

Add a scarf (secure with a stitch)
