



To make 1 pouch you need:

- 2 18" x 10" fabric
- 1 label
- 1 stitch template

If you have waterproof fabric in your kit, this is a lining for the pouch, so use 1 fabric & 1 waterproof lining.

### Instructions

Place the 2 main body pieces right sides together making sure the edges are aligned.

Lay the sewing template over so that it is equal all the way round. Either use a pencil to mark the stitch line or pin the template securely so it does not move while sewing.

Sew round the template guide/marking. Don't forget to leave a gap to turn it through. See marked on the template.

Trim the corners and snip the curves where necessary.

Turn through, working the curves and corners out for a smart finish. Press.

Fold up 6½" from the squared short edge to form a pouch. Take a folded label & insert it in the gap used to turn through. Fold over & top stitch ⅛" from the edge.

Sew a dividing line up the centre of the pouch to form 2 pockets

The snap fasteners will be added at HQ

(If it has fabric lining it will be a worry pouch and the faces will be applied at HQ)
