

Crochet lemon



This pattern is worked in the round. You can use a stitch marker to mark the first stitch of each round to help with counting stitches.

Count is shown in between []

Lemon in yellow. Make a magic ring/circle

Round 1: 6 dc into magic circle [6dc]

R2: 1dc into each stitch [6dc]

R3: 1dc, 2 dc into next st (increase), repeat [9dc]

R4: 1dc into each of the next 2 st, increase, repeat [12dc]

R5: 1dc, increase, repeat [18dc]

R6: 1dc into each of the next 2 st, increase, repeat [24dc]

R7: 1dc into each of the next 3 st, increase, repeat [30dc]

R8: 1dc into each of the next 4 st, increase, repeat [36dc]

R9: 1dc into each of the next 5 st, increase, repeat [42dc]

R10 to R21: 1dc into each st [42dc]

R22: 1dc into each of the next 5 st, dc2tog (decrease) [36dc]

R23: 1dc into each of the next 4 st, dc2tog (decrease) [30dc]

R24: 1dc into each of the next 3 st, dc2tog (decrease) [24dc]

R25: 1dc into each of the next 2 st, dc2tog (decrease) [18dc]

R26: 1dc into next st, dc2tog (decrease) [12dc]

R27: 1dc into each of the next 2 st, dc2tog (decrease) [9dc]

R28: 1dc into next st, dc2tog (decrease) [12dc]

R29: 1dc into next st, dc2tog (decrease) [6dc]

R30: dc2tog [3dc]

Leaves in green (make 2)

Ch8

Row 1: sl st into 2nd chain, sl st into next ch, 1 dc into next ch, 1htr into next ch, 1tr into each of the next 2ch, 3dr into next ch.



R2: you will work your stitches onto the other side of the chain. 1tr into same chain as the last tr, 1tr in the next ch, 1htr into next ch, 1dc into next ch, 1sl st into each of the next 2 ch. Fasten off With a darning needle, sew the leaves onto your lemon.
