

Tiny Teddy Pattern

Pattern by Louise Lindley



Please knit in white and in matching pairs.

Finished length is approximately 5.5cm - 6cm

They are fine without any stuffing as they are so tiny.

Using DK wool No 2.75mm Needles

Every row knit - Garter stitch

Leg 1 - Cast on 4st and work 8 rows - break yarn.

Leg 2 - Cast on 4st and work 8 rows

Body - Knit across all 8st

Knit 3 more rows

Arms - cast on 4st at beginning of next 2 rows

work 4 rows

Cast off 4st at beginning of next 2 rows

Head - work 22 rows on 8st

Arms - cast on 4st at beginning of next 2 rows

work 4 rows

Cast off 4st at beginning of next 2 rows

Body - Knit across all 8st

Knit 3 more rows

Legs - work on first 4st only, work 8 rows. Cast off.

Work 8 rows on remaining 4st. Cast off

Sew front and back of bear together. Sew across corners of the head to form ears.

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Stars - knitted star



Please knit in white and matching pairs.

Abbreviations:

st(s) - stitch(es)

k - knit

p - purl

sl - slip stitch (slip a stitch onto the right hand needle without working)

k2tog - knit 2 stitches together

psso - pass slipped stitch over.

Start knitting here

Cast on 55 sts.

Row 1 k4, sl1, k2tog, psso (k8, sl1, k2tog, psso) x4, k4 (45 sts)

Row 2 k3,sl1, k2tog, psso (k6, sl1, k2tog, psso) x4, k3 (35 sts)

Row 3 k2,sl1, k2tog, psso (k4, sl1, k2tog, psso) x4, k2 (25 sts)

Row 4 P to end.

Row 5 k1, sl1, k2tog, psso (k2, sl1, k2tog, psso) x4, k1 (15 sts)

Row 6 P to end

Row 7 sl1, k2tog, psso x5 (5 sts)

Break yarn, leave 30 cm to finish. With sewing up needle thread yarn through last 5 sts - pull tight. Using the same yarn join the short 7 row edges using a flat seam. Sew in cast-on tail. For a sharp star wash/dampen, pin out on rug/blanket, stretch star points outwards. Leave to dry.
